

The VIVO Trauma Life Support (VTLS) course is designed for the healthcare providers who are first to evaluate and stabilize the trauma patient. The courses provide complete training in the skills needed for rapid assessment, resuscitation, stabilization and transportation of trauma patients.

VTLS is standard training course for pre-hospital trauma care. VTLS course combine classroom learning and hands-on skill stations. Scenario assessment stations enable you to put your learning to work in simulated trauma situations.
